Jaibir Singh and Others FAO No. 842/03 as per clause 18 of MCTAP, to open MACT saving bank accounts in a nationalized bank near the place of their residence and the concerned banks are directed not to issue any cheque book and/or debit card to the petitioners and if the same has already been issued, the banks are directed to cancel the same and to make an endorsement on the passbooks of the petitioners to the effect that no cheque book and/or debit card shall be issued without the permission of the Court.
