Deposition of witness No. PW-50 for the prosecution recorded on oath or solemn affirmation under provision of OATHS ACT, 1969 (Act, 44 of 1969) on this 26th day of December, 2025 in the English language interpreted by me. Name- **Inspector Sukanta Tripura**, Age-49 years, son of Sri Dehendra Tripura, Residence-Belonia PS, Police Station-Belonia, District-South Tripura, Occupation-Govt. Service, Literate.

Cross examination by defence :-

1. The investigation in the case was conducted as per the procedures of PRB and Cr.P.C.
2. The distance of the alleged PO of the case would be around 2 kilometers from Belonia police station.
3. The distance of the alleged PO from Belonia SD hospital would be approximately one and half kilometer and the distance of the Fire Service Station from the PO would be around approximately 2 kilometers.
4. The incident of the case occurred on 01.12.2025 at around 23.00 hours and the information of the said incident was received by the duty officer of the PS, but I cannot recollect his name now.
5. I did not cite the duty officer of the police station who first received the information of the incident of the case as witness in the charge-sheet.

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6. Upon received of the information the mobile duty officer ASI of police namely Sri Sidhartha Das rushed to the spot at the relevant date and time.
7. ASI of police namely Sri Sidhartha Das returned back from the spot to the police station at around 5.30 am.
8. As per the provision of PRB and Cr.P.C when any information of the cognizable offence was/ is received by the police station, the O/C or any police officer of the police station is empowered to make a sou moto complaint against the said cognizable information.
9. At around 8.05 am I went to the spot and verified the matter.
10. After verification of the spot I did not intent for filing sou-moto complaint in connection with the incident as the matter was not clear at that stage of the case.
11. It is not a fact that the cognizable offence was not committed and sou-moto complaint was not filed thereafter for the same.
12. I returned back from the sport to the police station at around 14.20 hours, however, I did not mention the GDE number of my said return.
13. I did not treated the contents of GDE No.22, dated 02.12.2023 as sou moto FIR in connection with the case.
14. In the GDE No.22, dated 02.12.2023 I also mentioned that the source from which I received the information was engaged as a paid source by me.
15. On 02.12.2023 at around 8.10 pm a written complaint was filed

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before Belonia PS by one namely Sri Chandan Dey.

16. During inquest over the dead body of the deceased namely Asish Majumder, his brother namely Kusum Majumder was present at the spot and he put his signature in the said inquest report as one of the witness.

17. The inquest report was prepared by one ASI of police namely Sri Gopal Das.

18. In the said inquest report, as per version of the witnesses, it was mentioned that the said cause of death of Asish Majumder, was due to road traffic accident.

19. In the inquest report of Abhijit Dey, it was also mentioned that the cause of death was due to road traffic accident.

20. As per the contents of the PM reports of deceased Abhijit Dey and Asish Majumder appearing in column No.2, of the said reports it appears that the alleged history of death of the deceased persons were due to road traffic accident, in view of the information gathered by the police.

21. The vehicle Bolero is of two types, one is of Bolero pickup and another is Bolero car.

22. I did not collected the fire incident report in connection with the incident of the case.

23. It is not a fact that due to the want of the fire incident report the actual report of the incident could not be placed in the case.

24. As per the TSFSL, Toxicology Division report dated 09.02.2024 the

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results of chemical examination found to be Ethyl Alcohol detected in the viscera samples of the deceased namely Abhijit Dey.

25. Visceras of the deceased persons were kept in the malkhana go-down of the police station, however, in the register it was not maintain and no GDE was also not made against the said deposit.

26. The visceras of the deceased persons were sent before the TSFSL, Narsingarh on 27.12.2025.

27. I also collected two injury reports of the deceased persons from Belonia SD Hospital.

28. As per the two injury reports of the deceased persons prepared by the concerned attending doctors, the cause of the injuries as stated by the patient were due to road traffic accident.
