ORDER.

Baljinder Singh alias Babbu (applicant-accused) has filed instant application *under Section 483 BNSS, (Bhartiya Nagrik Suraksha Sanhita)* on the ground that, he is innocent and, has been falsely implicated in the present case. Moreover, the alleged recovery has already been effected. He is in judicial lock up since **19.08.2025**. Presentation of challan and conclusion of the same shall take a long

time. He is ready to abide by all the terms and conditions, if be released on bail till conclusion of trial. (*Application is duly supported with affidavit*).

2. Upon notice, ***learned Addl.P.P.*** for the State has appeared, but no reply has been filed. However, strongly opposed application and lastly prayed for dismissal of the same.

3. Police record produced. Perused.

4. I have heard ***Sh. GS Gill, Advocate*** counsel for accused-applicant and ***Ms. Teena, Learned Addl.P.P.*** for the State and have gone through the file carefully.

5. As per the allegations levelled by the prosecution, Inspector Gurdeep Singh (complainant) when alongwith other police officials were going in connection of patrolling in the area of Police Station Mallanwa and reached near seepage drain of Village Machiye Ke, spotted one person sitting thereon and on seeing the police party became perplexed and had thrown away polythene bag. He was intercepted. On search of the thrown away polythene paper bag, **05 grams of Heroin** was recovered. Thus, instant case under section **21,29/61/85 of NDPS Act** was got registered.

6. I have heard the rival submissions put forth by learned counsel for both parties. Recovery of alleged contraband has already

been effected. Accused/applicant is in judicial lock up since **19.08.2025**. Presentation of challan and conclusion of same shall take long time. Sufficient period of incarceration has already been spent by accused-applicant. Thus, no useful purpose will be served for detaining the accused behind bars for indefinite period. Hence, the bail application in hand, filed on behalf of ***Baljinder Singh alias Babbu*** (applicant-accused) is, hereby, ***allowed*** and he is ordered to be released on bail, on his furnishing bail bonds in the sum of Rs.50,000/- with one surety in the like amount, to the satisfaction of this court . However, these observation of mine shall have no effect on the merits of the case. Bail application file be tagged with remand papers.
