Despite service, none has appeared on behalf of the complainant.

2. Summoned record received. From the perusal of the summoned record it is revealed that the accused-applicant was summoned by the Ld. Trial Court in a complaint case to face trial under Sections 336,506,366,511,34 IPC and 25/27/54/59 of Arms Act.

3. In view of peculiar facts and circumstances of this case, custodial interrogation of the accused-applicant is not required. Consequently, his bail application is allowed provided that he shall surrender before the Ld. Trial Court within 10 days and on his doing so, he shall be admitted to bail by the Ld. Trial Magistrate on his furnishing personal bonds in the sum of ₹ 25,000/- with one surety in the like amount, to the satisfaction of Ld. Trial Court. Summoned record be sent back. Bail application file be consigned to the record room.
