**ORDER:**

This bail application pertaining to the court of Sh. Deepak Kumar Chaudhary, learned Addl. Sessions Judge, Amritsar is presented before me today, as the said court is availing summer vacations. Since, in the absence of Sh. Deepak Kumar Chaudhary,

learned Addl. Sessions Judge, Amritsar, this court has been asked to deal with the urgent matter, so, it is entertained by me.

ASI Surjit Singh No. 1702/Asr. is present alongwith record pertaining to this bail application. I have gone through the same especially recovery memo. From the same, it has been revealed that on 15.04.2019, ASI Surjit Singh recovered light pink colour 88 loose intoxicant tablets from his possession. The sample of said tablets was sent to the office of Chemical Examiner through HC Paramjit Singh No. 2488/Asr. and Assistant Director Regional Testing FSL, Amritsar on its analysis, gave his report as under:

Average weight = 115 mg/ tablet.

Alprazolam with average quantity of ingredient 0.43 mg/tablet.

Since, 88 tablets having average weight 115 mg per tablet were recovered from the possession of accused, so, on calculation, its net weight has come to 10.12 gm.

Whereas, at serial no.178 in a table, given at the back of NDPS Act, nature of quantity has been defined. As per the same, quantity of more than 100 gm of Alprazolam shall come to commercial quantity. Whereas, only 10.12 gm has been recovered from applicant, which falls within the category of non commercial

quantity and accused is in custody since the day of his arrest i.e. 15.04.2019. However, it will take time for the police to complete the investigation and then, to present the challan. So, in the given circumstances, no useful purpose will be served by unnecessarily detaining the applicant in custody.

Therefore, bail application moved by the accused/applicant is allowed and he is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds in the sum of Rs.75,000/- each with one surety in like amount. File be sent back to the court of Sh. Deepak Kumar Chaudhary, learned Addl. Sessions Judge, Amritsar.
