

ORDER

I.A.No.1 is filed by the plaintiff under Order XXXIX Rule 1 and 2 r/w/s 151 of C.P.C. seeking temporary injunction.

Heard the counsel for the plaintiff. Perused the averments of the plaint, I.A. and its supporting affidavit and also perused the documents produced along with the suit. At this pre-trial stage, the plaintiff has made out prima facie case. If notice on I.A.No.1 is issued to the

defendants No.1 to 5, it may lead to multiplicity of proceedings. Hence, by considering the grounds made in the affidavit accompanying the application, this Court views that prior notice on I.A.No.1 to the defendants No.1 to 5 has to be dispensed with. Hence, to meet ends of justice, the application is to be allowed. With this observation, I proceed to pass the following:-

ORDER

I.A.No.1 filed by the plaintiff under Order XXXIX Rule 1 and 2 r/w/s 151 of C.P.C. is hereby allowed till next date of hearing.

Exparte temporary injunction order is granted by temporarily restraining the defendants No.1 to 5, their agents or anybody claiming under them from alienating the suit schedule properties till next date of hearing.

Issue exparte T.I. order to defendants No.1 to 5 and suit summons to the defendants No.1 to 7 if the plaintiff comply with U/o.39 Rule 3(a) of CPC.

Office is also directed not to issue the certified copy of the order till compliance is made as required under law.
