At this stage, Ld. Counsel for defendant submits that she does not want to file any affidavit for admission denial. On the last time she had taken time for the purpose and even on the earlier date, time was given to her for filing documents for admission denial.

A cost of Rs. 6,000/- was also imposed upon the defendant while granting opportunity for filing affidavit/documents for admission denial, which she has now denied. This conduct is not appreciated by this Court.

It is now submitted by the parties that there is no document for admission denial. Hence, from the pleadings of the parties, the following issues are hereby framed:-

ISSUES

- 1. Whether the plaintiff is entitled for a decree in the sum of Rs. 18,90,240/- against the defendant along with interest, if any and if yes, at what rate, and for what period?OPP**
- 2. Whether the plaintiff is entitled for a decree in the sum of Rs. 2 lac against defendant towards damages and compensation with interest, if any, if yes, at what rate?OPP**
- 3. Whether the present suit is bad for non-joinder of necessary parties?OPD**
- 4. Relief.**

No other issue arises nor pressed for. Now, to come up for plaintiff evidence on 15.01.2019.

List of witnesses be filed within fifteen days from today. Advance copy of affidavit in evidence on behalf of the plaintiff be supplied to Ld.

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Counsel for the defendant at least one week before the next date, so that the plaintiff's witness could be cross-examined on that date.
