ORDER BELOW EX.1
(Passed on 14/03/2023)

This is an application filed under Section 2 of Bombay Regulation Act VIII of 1827 for grant of heir-ship certificate.

2] In brief, it is contention of applicant that her husband namely Rameshwar Narayan Solanke died on 11.07.2022 at village Songaon Tq. Anjangaon Surji, Dist. Amravati. It is further contention of applicant that her monther-in-law namely Chandrakala Narayan Solanke also died. The following persons are legal heirs of Rameshwar Narayan Solanke. Except them, there are no legal heirs of Rameshwar Narayan Solanke. Hence, she prayed for issuance of legal heir certificate.

3] The applicant filed on record certified copy of death certificate of her deceased husband vide list below Exh. 4. She has also filed copy of paper publication and verified copies of Adhar cards vide list below Exh. 7. The period mentioned in paper publication has been expired. During said period or thereafter no objection is received. In support of application, applicant examined herself at Exh. 08. She reiterated the contents of application. From the evidence of applicant, it is established that he himself and aforesaid persons are entitled to recognize as the legal heirs of deceased. Hence, I proceed to pass the following order.

ORDER

- 1] Application is allowed.
- 2] Issue heir-ship certificate in the name of aforesaid persons mentioned in paragraph 2 of this Order being formal legal heirs of deceased Rameshwar Narayan Solanke on payment of ad-valorem court fees in prescribed form as per rules.
