Since the matter was fixed for filing written statement and reply to the application U/o 39 Rule 1 and 2 CPC, which have not been filed so far.

Ld. Counsel for the defendants seeks time to file written statement and reply to the application U/o 39 Rule 1 and 2 CPC. Heard.

Record perused. On perusal of the record, it revealed that service of summons have been effected upon the defendants on 13.02.2026 and despite that, written statement has not been filed till date, which shows that the defendants are not willing to file written statement and reply to the interim application. However, in the interest of justice, the defendants are allowed to file written statement on or before the next date of hearing, subject to cost of Rs. 25,000/- each, out of which Rs. 10,000/- each shall be paid by the defendants to the plaintiff on next date of hearing and the rest of Rs. 15,000/- each shall be deposited by the defendants with Cash Branch, Central District, Tis Hazari Courts, Delhi.

Until and unless cost of Rs. 25,000/- each is paid by the defendants, written statement of the defendants shall not be taken on record. It is also made clear that the defendants shall not

claim exemption of the aforesaid cost of Rs. 25,000/- each under Income Tax.

Matter is adjourned.
