The petition is coming before me on 06.08.2026 for hearing and perusing the petition and on certifying the availability of seized conveyance, this court has passed the following order:

ORDER

Petition filed by the petitioner/complainant to certify the availability of seized Vehicle in B.No.661/2024 for the purpose of disposal by Drug Disposal Committee vide circular of **Hon'ble High Court in R.O.C.No.10143-A/2025/F1.**

The present petition has been filed by the prosecution for disposal of conveyance seized in the aforesaid case. The vehicle bearing Reg.No.TN 05 CJ 2247 (Honda Activa -Two wheeler) was already produced before the NDPS Court and 'B' number had been assigned and handed over to the police for interim custody. It has been stated in the petition that so far no one had claimed right over the property and to return the same. For the purpose of disposal by the Drug Disposal Committee, certification of availability of the conveyance sought for.

The photographs of the aforesaid vehicle with Panchnama drawn in the presence of VAO have been enclosed with the petition. The conveyance has been produced before this court through video mode as instructed in the R.O.C-No.10143-A/2025/F1 of Hon'ble High Court by the complainant police to certify the availability of seized conveyance,

The Hon'ble High Court of Madras in Circular dated 28.10.2025 in ROC No.10143-A/2025/F1 has held in point (xi) as follows-

"(xi) Taking Note of the High Court's circular in ROC No. 70917-4/2025/F1 dated 01.09.2025, it will suffice, if photograph is taken and pachanama is drawn in front of VAO. Production of vehicle before the Court can also be done through video mode."

In pursuance to the aforesaid circular of Hon'ble High Court, this court has ascertained the availability of conveyance produced through video mode. Panchanama verified. The investigation officer shall proceed with the destruction of the conveyance by filing necessary application under rule 17 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances (Seizure, Storage, Sampling and Disposal) Rules 2022 before the Drug Disposal Committee.

In the result, Petition is allowed and availability of below mentioned conveyance is certified and the complainant shall proceed with the destruction of the conveyance before the Drug Disposal Committee in accordance with law.
