ORDER:

1. This order of mine shall dispose of first application for regular bail under Section 483 of BNSS moved by accused/ applicant Varinder Singh in case FIR No.207 dated 30.08.2025, U/s. 21 NDPS Act, Police Station City-1, Abohar, wherein as per allegations of the police, 6 grams of heroin was allegedly got recovered from possession of the applicant-accused.
2. Learned counsel for the accused/applicant pressed for regular bail on the ground that the accused/applicant has been falsely implicated in this case. He further pressed that nothing has been recovered from the possession of accused/applicant. He further pressed that the present FIR is based on concocted facts and story. He further submitted that accused/applicant was arrested by the police on 30.08.2025 and since then he is in custody. He further submitted that no useful purpose would be

served by detaining accused/applicant into custody for an indefinite period and prayed for bail on these grounds.

3. Learned Additional Public Prosecutor opposed the bail application and prayed for dismissal of the same.

4. After hearing their respective submissions and perusal of record reveals the fact that on 30.08.2025 the police party headed by ASI Gurmail Singh apprehended accused/applicant Varinder Singh with 6 grams of heroin on the spot, which falls in non-commercial category. Accused/ applicant is in custody since 30.08.2025. The completion of investigation, presentation of challan and conclusion of trial would take long time. As such, no useful purpose would be served by detaining the accused/ applicant into custody for an indefinite period as pretrial detention would never be considered in the interest of justice. Keeping in view these facts and circumstances of the case, the instant bail application is hereby allowed and accused-applicant **Varinder Singh** is ordered to be released on bail on furnishing of bail bonds in the sum of Rs.10,000/- with one surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of learned Area Magistrate/learned Duty Magistrate. Ahlmad is directed to send the copy of order alongwith remand papers to the court of learned Area Magistrate/learned Duty Magistrate for compliance with the directions to send back the same alongwith bail bonds and surety bonds immediately after making compliance of order.

5. However, any observation given in this order shall not effect on merits of the main case. Copy of order be placed in the remand papers by the Ahlmad. One copy of this order be supplied/provided to System Assistant for forwarding the same to concerned Jail Authorities through e.mail. Police record be returned, whereas bail application file be consigned to the Record Room after due compilation.

Varinder Singh Vs State

Police record produced. Statement of HC Sawraj has been recorded, wherein he has got recorded that offence under section 27 of NDPS Act has been enhanced vide rapat No. 38 dated 04.09.2025. Learned counsel for the applicant-accused has also moved an application for addition of offence under section 27 of NDPS Act in the original bail application. Accordingly application is considered and allowed with the directions that present bail application shall also be considered for enhanced offence under section 27 of NDPS Act, as well.

One copy of bail order be supplied/provided to System Assistant for forwarding the same to concerned Jail Authorities through e.mail. Copy of order be also placed in the remand papers by the Ahlmad. Police record be returned, whereas bail application file be consigned to the Record Room after due compilation.
