

**ORDER BELOW EXH.No.06.**  
(passed on this 27<sup>th</sup> day of June 2018)

Perused the application supported with the affidavit. Heard Shri. J. L. Fadake, learned counsel for the petitioner. Gone through the documents placed on the record. The petitioner filed present petition under Sec.383 of Indian Succession Act, 1925 for revocation of succession certificate issued by this Court as per judgment dated 12.09.2017, wherein by filing this application she prayed to direct the respondent No.1 and 6 to 9 to deposit a sum of Rs.33,45,997.85 in this Court. However, the petitioner has not placed on the record any documentary proof to show that the respondent No.1 and 6 to 9 have withdrawn the said amount and at this stage it will not proper to pass such order. In the above circumstances before granting any ex-part order, it is necessary to hear the other side. Hence, I pass the following order.

**ORDER**

1. Issue show cause notice against the respondent No.1 and 6 to 9 as to why they should not be ordered to deposit a sum of Rs.33,45,997.85 in the Court.
2. E.P. and S.B. allowed.
