ORDER

File put up before me being Vacation Judge. Present bail
application has been filed by applicant Ramjot Singh son of Tajinder
seeking pre-arrest bail under Section 482 BNSS.

2. Upon notice, learned APP for the State put in appearance
on behalf of State. Police record was also requisitioned. ASI Sajjan
Singh, No.1149/GSP, P.S. Dorangla has appeared and suffered

statement that no FIR has been registered against applicant Ramjot Singh at Police Station Dorangla. He further stated that since no FIR has been registered against accused/applicant so far, his custodial interrogation is not required at this stage.

3. I have heard the arguments of learned APP for the State, learned counsel for the complainant as well as learned counsel for applicant and perused the record.

4 After hearing both the sides and after going through the statement of ASI Sajjan Singh, No.1149/GSP, P.S. Dorangla this court finds that no FIR has been registered against the applicant at Police Station Dorangla. Since no FIR has been registered against accused/applicant so far, his custodial interrogation is not required at this stage. Thus this court is of the opinion that the apprehension of the applicant that he would be arrested is misconceived. As such, the present bail application is hereby dismissed being infructuous. However, if any FIR is registered against the accused/applicant, he be duly served with the notice of the same within three days of the registration of the FIR. File be sent to the court of learned Sessions Judge Gurdaspur on 05.07.2025 for the purpose of entrustment.
