Offence : Punishable u/s.15 (C) r/w 63 of Kerala Abkari Act.

Plea : Guilty

Finding : Guilty

Sentence or Order : Accused is convicted and sentenced to pay a fine of ₹300/- for offence u/s.15 (C) r/w 63 of Kerala Abkari Act. In default of payment of fine, the accused shall undergo simple imprisonment for 7 days.

This case was finally heard on today, and this Court delivered the following:-

JUDGMENT

1. The accused stands charge sheeted by the Excise Inspector, Kottarakkara Excise Range alleging for the commission of offences punishable u/s.15 (C) r/w 63 of Kerala Abkari Act.
2. On appearance of accused before the court. Copies of relevant prosecution records were furnished to the accused. Particulars of offence were read over and explained, to which he pleaded guilty. Since the plea is voluntarily, the same is accepted. The accused is found guilty of offences punishable u/s.15 (C) r/w 63 of Kerala Abkari Act and convicted him thereunder.
3. Considering the nature of the offence, I am of the opinion that this is not a fit case to apply the benevolent provisions of Probation of Offenders Act.

In the result, the accused is sentenced to pay a fine of ₹300/- for offence u/s.15 (C) r/w 63 of Kerala Abkari Act. In default of payment of fine, the accused shall undergo simple imprisonment for 7 days.
