12/01/2026	Informant is absent since long. Case record put up for order on final form submitted by Investing Officer. On repeated call, none appeared on behalf of informant. Heard Ld. DPO, who submitted that he has no objection against the final form submitted by the IO and closure of the case. Perused the case record. From record, it transpires that Forbesganj Police Station has registered an F.I.R. bearing Forbesganj P.S. Case No. 439/2025 against Unknown thief. Investigating Officer (I.O.) after investigation, submitted the case-diary along with final form u/s 193 B.N.S.S. The I.O. has submitted final form bearing Sl. From perusal of the case-diary, statements of witnesses recorded during investigation and final form submitted by IO, this Court doesn't find <i>prima facie</i> material on record to proceed further in this case. As per the directions of the Hon'ble High Court of Judicature at Patna, final form has to be disposed of on priority basis. Hence, final form submitted by the Investigating Officer is accepted and case is closed.
