File taken up on an application and put up in Pre Lok Adalat in view of letter received from the office of Ld. Chief Judicial Magistrate-cum-SDLsA, Narnaul vide Endst No. 2838-41 dated 13.05.2024.

Today, plaintiff Sukhbir Singh vide his separate recorded statement stated that matter has been compromised with the defendant and as per compromise he has received the due amount from defendant, therefore, he is not desirous to proceed further with the present suit and same may be dismissed as withdrawn. He further prayed that court fees annexed with plaint be refunded to him and he has no objection qua cancellation of attachment of property of defendant done in view of order dated 11.10.2023.

Further, learned counsel for the defendant vide his separate recorded statement also stated that matter has been compromised between the parties and he has no objection, in returning/refunding of court fees to the plaintiff. He further prayed that order dated 11.10.2023, vide which property of the defendant was attached, may kindly be cancelled. Heard. Keeping in view the said statements suffered by the plaintiff as well as counsel for the defendant, the present suit is hereby **dismissed as withdrawn**. The Court fee annexed with the plaint be refunded/returned to the plaintiff as per section 21 of Legal Services Authority Act, against proper identification and verification.

Further, attachment of the property of defendant done in view of order dated 11.10.2023, passed by Sh. Sohan Lal Malik, learned Predecessor of this Court stands cancelled. *Consequently, intimation in this regard to the revenue official concerned/Tehsildar, Mohindergarh be immediately send.* File be consigned to the record room after due compliance.
