An application on behalf of plaintiff u/s 151 CPC for seeking time to file court fee is filed by plaintiff. The same is taken on record.

Order on IA u/s 151 CPC.

It is submitted that vide order dated 11.02.2025, applicant was directed to file court fee. It is further submitted that both the plaintiff have no permanent source of income and the plaintiff no. 1 is student and the plaintiff no.2 is doing a temporary job and getting a salary of Rs.7000/- p.m. and she is only bread earner of her family. It is further submitted that in arranging court fee, it will take some time, therefore, a time is required for arranging money for court fee. Id. Counsel for plaintiff also submits that one month time may be given to the plaintiff to file the court fee. Hence, the present application.

During the course of arguments, Id. Counsel for defendant submits that he has no objection if the present application be allowed and time be given to plaintiff to file court fee.

In view of above submissions as well as facts and circumstances of the present case, the present application stands allowed.

Plaintiff is given one month time to file the requisite court fee.
