ORDER BELOW EX.1
(Passed on 05/10/2023)

This is an application filed under Section 2 of Bombay Regulation Act VIII of 1827 for grant of heir-ship certificate.

2] In brief, it is contention of applicant that his father and mother namely Dinkar Bhagwantrao Chinchale (Bramhan) and Kusum Dinkarrao Chinchale died on 02.05.1956 and 14.07.2022 at Nimbhari Dhote, Tq. Anjangaon Surji, Dist. Amravati respectively. The applicant is the only legal heir of deceased Dinkar Bhagwantrao Chinchale (Bramhan) and Kusum Dinkarrao Chinchale. Except him, there are no legal heirs of deceased Dinkar Bhagwantrao Chinchale (Bramhan) and Kusum Dinkarrao Chinchale. Hence, he prayed for issuance of legal heir certificate.

3] The applicant filed on record certified copy of death certificate of his deceased mother, certified copy of death register of his deceased father, verified copy of Aadhar cards and copy of paper publication at Exh.12 to 16. The period mentioned in paper publication has been expired. During said period or thereafter no objection is received. In support of application, applicant examined himself at Exh.08. He reiterated the contents of application. From the evidence of applicant, it is established that aforesaid person is entitled to recognize as the legal heir of deceased Dinkar Bhagwantrao Chinchale (Bramhan) and Kusum Dinkarrao Chinchale. Hence, I proceed to pass the following order.

ORDER

- 1] Application is allowed.
- 2] Issue heir-ship certificate in the name of applicant mentioned in paragraph 2 of this Order being formal legal heirs of deceased **Dinkar Bhagwantrao Chinchale (Bramhan)** and **Kusum Dinkarrao Chinchale** on payment of ad-valorem court fees in prescribed form as per rules.
