Accused Sri Bani Kanta Choudhury is present.

Copies of relevant documents are furnished to the accused.

I have heard both sides and also perused the record and all other relevant documents.

On perusal of the same I have found prima facie materials presuming commission of offences punishable under Section 281/125(b)/324(4) of BNS by the accused and accordingly formal charge of offences punishable under Section 281/125(b)/324(4) of BNS is framed against the accused and contents of the charge are read over and explained to the accused to which he has pleaded guilty.

The accused vide petition No. 2505/25 has pleaded guilty.

The plea of guilt of the accused is recorded in separate sheet and tagged in record.

The plea of guilt is found voluntary and thus accepted.

Considering that the accused has pleaded his guilt, the accused is convicted for commission of offence under Section 281/125(b)/324(4) of BNS.

Accused has pleaded mercy of Court while during hearing on point of sentence recorded in separate sheet. No previous conviction of like offence is found. In my opinion thus, a sentence of fine would be justified.

Considering all aspects, the accused is sentenced to pay a fine of Rs. 1,000/- for commission of offence under Section 281 of BNS, Rs. 5000/- for commission of offence under Section 125(b) of BNS and Rs. 1000 for commission of offence under Section 324(4) of BNS; in default of payment of fine to undergo Simple Imprisonment for 6 (Six) months.

The case is disposed of accordingly.
