ORDER

1. Present petition has been filed by petitioner seeking regular bail under Section 439 of Cr.P.C. for the alleged commission of offences as mentioned above.
2. Upon notice, learned Additional P. P. put in appearance and contested the bail application. Police record was requisitioned and perused.
3. The case of the prosecution is that on 16.08.2023, in the area of T point Village Dheer, two persons were intercepted by police during checking who were coming on car. They were apprehended on suspicion. On enquiry, they disclosed their names as Arjan Bhatti

and applicant Robinjit Singh. On checking, 40 grams heroin was recovered from accused Arjan Bhatti whereas one electronic scale (kanda) was recovered from applicant Robinjit Singh. They were arrested and since then applicant is in custody.

4. I have heard the arguments of learned counsel for petitioner as well as of learned Additional Public Prosecutor and perused the record.

5. Petitioner is in custody since 16.08.2023 for the alleged recovery of one electronic scale (Kanda) whereas 40 gram heron was recovered from his co-accused. Above quantity of heroin falls in the category of non commercial quantity. Conclusion of investigation and presentation of challan will take sufficient long time. No purpose would be served by keeping the petitioner behind bars for indefinite period, as such, present application is hereby allowed and petitioner is admitted to regular bail on his furnishing bail bonds in the sum of Rs.50,000/- with one surety in the like amount, in the Court of learned Illaqa/Duty Magistrate to his/her satisfaction and subject to the following conditions:-

- i. That he shall not hinder the ongoing investigation;
- ii. That he shall not leave the country without prior permission of the Court;
- iii. That he shall not make any threat, promise or inducement to any person conversant with the facts of the case to dissuade him/her from disclosing the truth to the Court or police;

Copy of this order be attached with remand papers. Bail bonds be sent back to Special Court, after furnishing the same by applicant within 5 days immediately. Record of bail application be consigned to the record room.
