Present: Sh. ASHWANI SHARMA, Advocate for the complainant.

Receipt of RC is placed on record. Statutory period 30 days have already elapsed, since service upon the accused through ordinary process. Further, as per the submissions of the Ld. Counsel on behalf of the Complainant, the accused is intentionally and willfully avoiding service. Given the facts and circumstances, the Court is of the view that there remains no other option but to adopt coercive methods to procure the presence of the accused.

As such, let bailable warrants be issued against the accused in the sum of Rs. 5,000/- with one surety in like amount for 10.06.2026.

The complainant is at liberty to accompany the Serving Constable to ensure proper execution of the warrants.
