I have perused the chargesheet and other material
placed on record by the IO. The offence alleged in the instant case
pertains to Section 285 BNS.

There is sufficient material on record with respect to
the ingredient of the aforesaid offences. Hence, I take cognizance
of offences U/s 285 BNS.

In compliance of Section 230 BNSS, copy of
chargesheet alongwith documents has been supplied to the accused
against acknowledgement.

Arguments heard on the point of notice. It is argued by

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accused that she is innocent and deserves to be discharged.

Per contra, Ld. APP has argued that there is sufficient material on record to put the accused person on trial and notice U/s. **285 BNS** is prima facie made out.

Submissions heard. Record perused.

From the perusal of the entire record and after hearing the arguments, I am of the considered opinion that notice U/s. **285 BNS** is prima-facie is made out against the accused person.

Notice is separately framed. The same is read over and explained to the accused person in vernacular language to which the accused person has pleaded not guilty and claimed trial.

At this stage, the accused is called upon to admit/deny the genuineness of the documents. Separate statement recorded under Section 294 CrPC/330 BNSS. Accordingly, the witnesses mentioned at serial No. 2 and 3 stand dropped from the list of witnesses.

At this stage, an application for plea-bargaining in terms of section 290 BNSS has been moved on behalf of the accused.

Submissions heard.

Notice has been framed against the accused and thirty days have not elapsed from the date when notice was framed.

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In view of the submissions made, matter is hereby referred for Pre-Sitting of Lok Adalat today itself for consideration on the application.

PRE-SITTING OF LOK ADALAT

This Court is holding Pre-Sitting of Lok Adalat today itself so as to avoid overcrowding in the Court when the National Lok Adalat is scheduled to be held. The accused is facing trial for the offence u/s 285 BNS. The applicant/accused was examined by this Court and this Court is satisfied that the applicant/accused has voluntarily moved the application and understood the nature of accusation against her as also the nature and extent of punishment under the law. After understanding the same, accused has chosen to plead guilty.

Therefore, this court proceeds to record the statement of the parties.
