



ORDER BELOW EXH.No.01

1. As per oral directions in V.C. of Hon'ble Principal District Judge, and in view of letter of the Hon'ble Chief Judicial Magistrate, Nashik bearing O. No. 950/2026 dtd. 15/07/2026 this matter is taken up for disposal under section 258 of Criminal Procedure Code.
2. Perused the record and proceedings.
3. The matter is of Summery Trial. The matter is pending since 2023. The matter is more than five years old and pending without any fruitful gain.
4. In this case the complaint has been filed against the accused for commission of an offence punishable under Section 66(1)/192 of Motor Vehicles Act.
5. The matter is pending apperance of the accused. The prosecution is failed to secure the presence of accused. The offence is not much serious as to keep it pending.
6. In such circumstances, in my view no purpose would serve by keeping the proceeding pending any more. The proceeding will have to be disposed of in view of the provisions as contained in Section 258 of the Code

of Criminal Procedure. In view of the above discussion, I pass the following order-

ORDER

1. The case is disposed off under Section 258 of the Criminal Procedure Code.
2. The accused is hereby acquitted from the offence punishable under Section 66(1)/192 of Motor Vehicles Act vide under Section 258 of Code of Criminal Procedure.
3. The bail bonds if any, stands cancelled and surety is discharged.
