1. Written statement along with Statement of Truth; list of documents with documents; affidavit of admission/denial; application under Order VIII Rule 1 with vakalatnama of ld. counsel, were filed on 10.06.2026.
2. Rejoinder to written statement with reply to application has been filed on behalf of plaintiff today. Copy of rejoinder had already been received by the defendant.
3. Submissions heard on application under Order VIII Rule 1 CPC.
4. It is disclosed by defendant itself that defendants were served on 17.04.2026 probably through post and there had been some delay due to legal team being based in Pune. Keeping in view the fact that written statement was filed within maximum permissible period and for the given reasons, written statement is taken on record. However, verification clause of written statement has alterations made by counsel, which makes it unacceptable. Similarly, in Statement of Truth blank space was left in para 6, which makes it incomplete. Another opportunity is given to file written statement with fresh verification without

any alteration, with fresh Statement of Truth without changing the other contents.

5. Now to come up for framing of issues and case management hearing on **07.09.2026**.
