	23.12.22	G.R.-1712/2022 Bistupur P.S.-236/2022 Bail petition having MCA No. 8159/22 filed on behalf of custody accused namely Roshan Patar is pressed today and the same is taken up for hearing. Copy of the same has already been served upon the learned A.P.P. Arguments has been advanced. Heard both sides. Learned counsel for the accused-petitioner has submitted that petitioner is in judicial custody since 23.09.2022 and he is innocent and has not committed any offence, rather he has been falsely implicated in this case. Learned counsel has further submitted that nothing has been recovered from the possession of the petitioner and other co-accused have already been granted bail on the basis of their juvenility. It has further been submitted that investigation in the instant case has completed and now the charges have been framed. Lastly, it has been prayed to release the petitioner on bail. Ld. A.P.P has opposed the bail on the ground that the offences are serious and non-bailable. On perusal of the case record, it appears that petitioner is facing allegation for the offences punishable u/s 379/411 of Indian Penal Code. As per FIR allegation against the petitioner is that he committed theft of scooty of the informant while he parked his vehicle in front of Traffic Police Station. It is further alleged that some articles as well	

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contd. 23.12.22	as Rs. 10,000/- kept in the dicky of the scooty has also been stolen away by unknown thieves. It further appears that petitioner was arrested and remanded in this case on the basis of seizure of said scooty and his confessional statement. It further appears that in the instant case charge sheet has been submitted and cognizance for the offences punishable u/s 379/411 of Indian Penal Code has been taken against the petitioner and others. Moreover, after supplying the police paper formal charges for the offences punishable u/s 379/411 of Indian Penal Code has been framed, read over and explained to the accused and subsequent to their denial thereof, trial against them has been commenced, but petitioner is in judicial custody since 23.09.2022. After considering the submissions of both parties, facts and circumstances of the case, period of custody and commencement of trial, accused-petitioner Roshan Patar is ordered to be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- with two sureties of the like amount each with condition that one bailor must be close relative of the petitioner.
