Order No.03, dated 17.07.2026

An application under section 483 of B.N.S.S/439 of Cr.P.C. is filed by the petitioner/accused namely, **Raja Kumar** who is in custody in connection with **Lake P.S (D.D) cyber crime branch Kolkata case no. 69 dated 15/04/2026 under section 61(2)/319(2)/318(4)/336(3)/338/340(2) BNS, 2023 since added sec 66C/66D IT Act 2000 and sec 204/308(2) BNS 2023** is taken up for hearing.

Ld. Advocate for the accused/petitioner submits that no such application U/s. 483 of B.N.S.S/439 of Cr.P.C is filed or pending or rejected before the Higher Court.

Ld. Advocate on behalf of the accused/petitioner submits that the present accused/petitioner has been falsely implicated in this case and he is in custody since 15/05/2026. It is further submitted that he has no criminal antecedents and if he is enlarged on bail, he would not abscond or tamper with the evidence in any manner whatsoever. As such, he prayed for bail of the accused/petitioner.

Ld. P.P.-in-charge produces the C.D. and raises objection against the prayer for bail of the accused/petitioner and submitted that there are materials in CD against the accused /petitioner. Hence, he prayed for rejection of the prayer for bail of the present accused/petitioner.

Heard both sides at length.

I have gone through the CD.

On perusal of the CD it appears that one of the accused persons have already been enlarged on bail. Investigation has progressed to a large extent. As investigation is mainly depending upon the documentary and electronic evidence which are now under the authority of financial organizations and bank this Court feels that further detention of this accused/petitioner is not required for the purpose of investigation. Accordingly, prayer for bail u/s 483 of B.N.S.S. Act, 2023 (sec. 439 Cr.PC.) of the petitioner/accused is allowed.

The above named accused/petitioner, may find bail of **Rs.5,000/-**, with two sureties of **Rs.2,500/-** each, subject to the satisfaction of the Ld. C.J.M., Alipore **with condition that he shall meet I.O once in every week till completion of investigation and shall not leave the jurisdiction of the Kolkata City till investigation is over.**

Thus, the Crl. Misc. Case is disposed of.
