**NARCOTICS CONTROL BUREAU Vs. JAI
SINGH SEKHAWAT**

It is submitted that IO Kumar Chandan is deputed
for Electoral duties. In the circumstances, issue notice to the IO
seeking status of supplementary complaint against accused Ajay
Singh Sekhawat for **04.05.2026**.

At this stage, an application seeking 12 days JC
remand of accused Ajay Singh Sekhawat is moved.

It is submitted by the IO that the investigation is still
pending and in order to conduct the proper investigation and to
prevent the accused from committing similar offences in the
future and to prevent him from tampering with the evidence, he

may be further remanded to judicial custody. The custody is also sought to prevent the accused from approaching the witnesses and to ensure his timely presence at the time of trial.

Considering the allegations made and the grounds stated in the application moved by the IO, the Court is satisfied with the justification furnished for extension of judicial custody of the accused.

Accordingly, in view of the grounds stated and the submissions made, the present application is hereby allowed and the accused Ajay Singh Sekhawat is hereby remanded to 12 days JC till **04.05.2026**. He be produced on the said day before the Court in person.
