M/S BANSAL CONSTRUCTION v. UNION OF INDIA

Present: Sh. Pooja Dua, ld. counsel for Award Holder.
Sh. Nitish Pandey, ld. counsel for Award Debtor.

There is no compliance of last order, from the side of Award Debtor Department. Mr. Pandey submits that Senior DEN concerned was on leave for last two days, therefore, affidavit of calculation could not be signed and filed. One affidavit with calculation of interest was filed on behalf of Award Debtor.

With given time period of two months, the kind of excuse given on behalf of Award Debtor, was the least expected thing. Such excuse cannot be entertained for non-compliance and for causing delay in the proceedings.

Though ld. counsel for Award Debtor verbally acknowledges that only principal amount has been tendered and interest has not been tendered, Award Debtor is also expected to act and make calculation in accordance with law and relevant provision is Section 31(7) of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, to calculate the post Award interest and to tender the same.

Case is adjourned subject to cost of Rs.25,000/- to be paid by Award Debtor to Award Holder and the amount on account of interest accumulated till next date, shall be also tendered by Award Debtor in the form of FDR, along with calculation of interest in the form of affidavit. Concerned official shall appear before the court to explain the calculation.
