This petition coming on 06.08.2026 for final hearing before me in the presence of Sri.K. Saleem, Learned Counsel for the Petitioner/Accused ; and of Smt P. Manjula Devi, Learned Additional Public Prosecutor for the Respondent/Complainant; and the matter having been heard and stood over for consideration till today, this court delivered the following:

**ORDER**

1. This is the second bail Petition filed under Section 483 of Bharatiya Nagrik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023. (hereinafter referred to as "B.N.S.S.") seeking regular bail to the Petitioner/Accused who is Accused No.1 in Cr.No.441/2026 of Police Station, Ibrahimpatnam. The Petitioner/ Accused No.1 has been in judicial custody since 27-06-2026.

2. The case of the Prosecution is that the Petitioner/Accused No.1 is involved in intermediary quantity of Narcotic Drugs I.e., **2 Kgs 960**

**grams of Dry Ganja** and seized the Material objects i.e., one Apple iphone and one digital weighing machine which were used at the time of commission of offence under the cover of panchanama in the presence of the mediators.

3. The Charges alleged against the Petitioner/Accused No.1 is for the offences Under Section 8(C) r/w. 20 (b)(ii)(B) of N.D.P.S. Act.

4. Heard both sides and perused the material available on record.

5. Now the point that arises for determination before this Court is that "Whether the Petitioner/Accused No.1 is entitled for the relief as prayed for"?

**POINT:-**

6. The Petitioner is Accused in Cr. No.1083/2026 of Police Station Ibrahimpatnam for the offence under Section 8(c)r/w.20(b)(ii)(B) of N.D.P.S Act and that he has been remanded to judicial custody since 27.06.2026.

7. Perused the record and Case Diary file. On perusal of the Case Diary and record, it is seen that the Petitioner/Accused alleged to have been found in possession of **2 Kgs 960 grams of Dry Ganja** which is Intermediary quantity and as per the prosecution there are no other offences pending against the Petitioner/Accused and there is no previous involvement of the Petitioner/Accused in any offence and that he is in judicial custody since 27.06.2026 and the major part of the investigation is being concluded as the quantity seized being the

Intermediary quantity, as such the bar under Section 37 of the N.D.P.S. Act will not be applicable in this case. As such, I hold that the Petitioner/Accused No.1 can be enlarged on bail.

**8(a). IN THE RESULT,** the petition is **allowed** and accordingly, the Petitioner/Accused No.1 is ordered to be enlarged on bail on his executing a personal bond for a sum of **Rs.25,000/-** (Rupees Twenty Five Thousand only) with two sureties for the like sum each to the satisfaction of the XV Addl. Metropolitan Magistrate at Ibrahimpatnam, Rangareddy District.

**8(b).** The Petitioner/Accused No.1 is further directed to appear before the **Station House Officer, Police Station Ibrahimpatnam** on **Monday** and **Saturday** of every week at any time in between 10.30 A.M. to 2.00 P.M. and mark his attendance for a period of three months or till filing of charge sheet, whichever is earlier.

**8(c).** The Petitioner/Accused No.1 shall not directly or indirectly make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade from disclosing such facts to the Court or the Police Officer.

**8(d).** The Petitioner/Accused No.1 shall co-operate with the investigating agency as and when required.

**8(e).** The Petitioner/Accused No.1 shall not commit an offence similar to the offence of which he is accused, or suspected, of the commission of which he is suspected.
