Present : Sh. Rajat Sarawat, Ld. Counsel for the plaintiff.

Defendant no.1 in person.

No report of service had been received except in respect of WhatsApp, but WhatsApp was showing single click only, which cannot be treated as valid service. Dasti summons shall be taken by AR of plaintiff to be served upon defendant no.2, on filing of PF. Report shall be filed in the form of affidavit.

Defendant no.1 has appeared on the basis of information given to her by officials of plaintiff company and she has filed self attested copy of her election I-card. She has been supplied complete paper book by ld. counsel for plaintiff. Period of 30 days to file written statement for defendant no.1 shall be counted from today. Along with written statement, defendant no.1 shall also file affidavit/statement of admission/denial of the document filed by the plaintiff as per Order XI CPC as amended by the Commercial Courts Act, 2015. Advance copy of the same shall be supplied to plaintiff or his counsel. Defendant no.1 has been informed about aforesaid time limit as well as about legal aid services available to her.

At this stage, it is submitted that defendant no.1 and plaintiff are ready to explore the possibilities of settlement. They pray that the matter be sent to the Mediation Centre in this regard.

Accordingly, the matter is referred to the Mediation Centre, Patiala House Court, New Delhi and the parties are

directed to appear before the Incharge Mediation Centre for 08.06.2026 at 12:00noon. The parties/counsel are directed to submit their e-mail addresses and mobile phone numbers to the reader of this court. Reader of this court is directed to fill up form B of referral order accordingly and to forward the same to the Mediation Centre along with copy of this order. The referral order be sent to the Mediation Centre. Parties to contact Mediation Centre accordingly.

Put up this matter for report before this court on 25.08.2026.
