It is stated by the Ld. Counsels for the parties that petition under Section 34 of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 filed by the respondent has been dismissed by the court of Ld. District Judge (Commercial), Tis Hazari Courts, Delhi.

Ld. Counsel for the decree holder submits that that the judgment debtor has deposited FDR in the name of the court as per order dated 08.02.2022 and since the petition under Section 34 of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 has been dismissed by the court of Ld. District Judge (Commercial), Tis Hazari Courts, Delhi, the FDR be released to the decree holder.

Ld. Counsel for the judgment debtor submits that they have not received the copy of the order passed by the court of Ld. District Judge (Commercial), Tis Hazari Courts, Delhi and two weeks time be granted to the judgment debtor to apprise the court whether the judgment debtor intends to challenge the order passed by the court of Ld. District Judge (Commercial), Tis Hazari Courts, Delhi or not.

This is no ground for adjourning the present matter and not to clear the amount of the decree holder. However, in the interest of

justice, put up this matter for further proceedings, on 31.07.2023.
