ORDER BELOW EXH.1 IN M.A.C. PETITION NO.334 OF 2023

1. Parties have produced Compromise pursis at **Exh.23**. As per order passed below Compromise pursis, the same is recorded and accepted.
2. The claimants and the opponent No.3 – insurance company have entered into compromise settling the claim to the tune of **Rs.4,90,000/- (Rupees Four Lakhs Ninety Thousand Only)**. The Compromise Pursis produced by the parties is read over to them. Thus, this Tribunal is of the opinion that the settlement arrived between the parties is legal and within the purview of subject matter of the claim petition and also in the interest of claimant. The compromise is, therefore, recorded in exercise of the powers conferred under Order 23 of the Civil Procedure Code. Hence, following order is passed:

:: ORDER ::

1. **Opponent No.3 - National Insurance Co. Ltd.** is hereby ordered to deposit an amount of **Rs.4,90,000/- (Rupees Four Lakhs Ninety Thousand Only)** in the office of this Tribunal towards full and final compensation within a period of **one (1) month** from the date of this order.
2. On failure to deposit the awarded amount within the aforesaid stipulated time, then interest at the rate of 7%p.a. shall be levied on the opponent – Insurance Company.

3. The office shall not deduct or recover the amount of Court fees from the awarded amount deposited with this Tribunal, as the matter is compromised in Lok-Adalat.
4. Court Fees Refund Certificate, as the case may be, be issued in the name of the claimant/s, if he/they has/have paid Court fees, if any.
5. On deposition of awarded amount, detailed disbursement order will be passed.
6. In view of the above, the present claim petition stands disposed off accordingly as compromised in Lok-Adalat.
