ORDER

Today, HC Hardeep Singh suffered a statement (recorded separately) that in compliance with the order dated 04.09.2023, the applicants had joined the investigation on 07.09.2023. Their custodial interrogation is not required.

2. Heard learned counsel for the accused-applicants and learned Additional P. P. for the State and have also perused the record.

3. In this case, vide order dated 04.09.2023, the applicants were directed to join the investigation, who have abided by the orders of the Court. Neither any recovery is to be effected from them, nor they are required for any investigation. So far the allegations of prosecution are concerned, those are matters to be adjudicated upon after taking evidence on the file. Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the case, the bail application is allowed and the interim bail order is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438 (2) (i) (ii) and (iii) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
