AWARD

1. The present matter and the criminal case have been settled between the petitioner and respondent no. 1 for a total sum of Rs.2,50,000/-(Rupees Two Lakh Fifty Thousand only)

before the Mediation Centre on 01.09.2026 in full and final settlement of claim amount. Statements of Ld. Counsel for petitioner and respondent no. 1 have been recorded in this regard.

2. In view of statements made, an award in the sum of Rs.2,50,000/-(Rupees Two Lakh Fifty Thousand only) in favour of the petitioner and against respondent is passed towards full and final settlement of claim of the petitioner for compensation in respect of injuries suffered by him in the accident, which is subject matter of present DAR arising out of FIR No.133/25, under Sections 281/125(b) BNS & Sections 146/196 MV Act, PS Chanakyapuri.

3. It has been agreed between the parties that out of the aforesaid settlement amount, an amount of Rs.7,000/- will be paid by respondent no. 1 to the claimant through online transfer today itself, an amount of Rs.93,000/- shall be payable by respondent no. 1 on 04.11.2026 before this Tribunal and the remaining amount of Rs.1,50,000/- shall be payment by respondent no. 1 before the criminal court on 30.04.2027 at the time of compounding/quashing of criminal case.

4. Respondent no. 1 is directed to pay the entire balance amount on time, failing which it is liable to pay interest at the rate of 9% per annum for the period of delay.

5. A copy of this award be given to the parties free of cost and be sent by email. Ahlmad is directed to send the copy of the award to the concerned Judicial Magistrate and Delhi Legal Services Authority, New Delhi District in view of Judgment titled as Rajesh Tyagi Vs. Jaibir Singh & Ors. passed in FAO no.842/2003 dated 12.12.2014.

6. Further, Nazir is directed to maintain the record in Form XVIII as per the directions given by the Hon'ble Delhi High Court in Rajesh Tyagi's case on 08.01.2021.
