This is an application seeking modification of bail order dated 10.07.2024 to the effect that he may be allowed to mark his attendance in NCB office, R K Puram, Delhi on first Monday of every month through VC, instead of appearing there in person.

It is submitted by Ld counsel for accused/applicant that co accused Mujeepur Rahaman, who is the main accused of the present case, through whom the recovery was effected was granted bail by this court vide order dated 0810.2024 and in the said order sheet at the condition no. 5, the Ld Predecessor of this court had allowed the co-accused to mark his presence at NCB Office through VC. The applicant/accused is claiming parity with the co accused.

It is fairly stated by Ld proxy counsel for NCB that the present application may be allowed, since, the marking of attendance through VC shall suffice the deterrent and to ensure that the applicant/accused does not abscond during trial, especially when, similar conditions qua co accused were put.

In the considered opinion of this court, the applicant/accused has been able to make out his case for parity with co accused Mujeepur Rahaman and the present application is hereby allowed, in the interest of justice, the earlier passed bail order dated 10.07.2024, especially the condition no. 5 is hereby amended, to allow the applicant/accused to either appear through VC or in person. The remaining conditions shall remain the same. The order dated 10.07.2024 shall be read with the present order sheet and is hereby amended accordingly and disposed off.

The copy of the order be given dasti to parties.
