NCB Vs. MUKESH PU AND ORS.

There is one time bound case listed before the court today. Additionally, about 25 misc. applications including more than 10 for bail are also listed.

One of the stenographer is on leave today and no substitute stenographer is available in the post lunch session.

All accused persons are present on bail.

Matter is listed for arguments on charge. However, Ld. SPP for NCB seeks an adjournment submitting that NCB intends to challenge the order dated 20.07.2026.

Ld. Sr. Advocate for accused no. 4 and other counsels objects to the adjournment being sought stating that valuable right to a speedy trial of the accused persons is being affected and that the accused persons have already argued the matter once. It is submitted that the adjournment sought is not justified.

Considering the fact that in any case, the Court can not conclude hearing on arguments on charge in one sitting, the arguments advanced on behalf of accused no. 4 on the point of charge are heard.

Matter be listed for arguments on charge qua other accused persons and the NCB on **30.07.2026**.
