**APPLICATION DATED 13.05.2025 UNDER SECTION 483
OF THE BHARTIYA NAGRIK SURAKSHA SANHITA, 2023
ON BEHALF OF THE APPLIANT KARAN DEV.**

Heard on the bail application.

Ld. Counsel for the accused submitted that the applicant is in custody since 01.02.225. He is permanent resident of Delhi. Ld. Counsel further submitted that on 31.01.2025 there was a fight between the complainant and applicant and thereafter, the applicant left the premises.

The complainant lodged a false FIR after inflicting injuries on herself with a knife. The fact that there was no fingerprints on the knife itself shows that this is self inflicted injury. There is also delay in recording her statement as the incident took place on 31.01.2025 but her statement was recorded only on 28.03.2025. Ld. Counsel further submitted that investigation is complete and no purpose will be served by keeping him in custody and prayed that he be released on bail.

Ld. Addl. PP for State opposed the bail and submitted that there are serious allegation against the accused. The accused wanted to marry with her, which was refused by the complainant, which was not liked by the applicant and thereafter he stabbed her with the knife. Ld. Addl. PP for State further

submitted that statement of the victim is yet to be recorded. It is prayed that keeping in view the gravity of the offence, he be not granted bail.

Keeping in view the submissions and fact that the allegations against the accused are that he stabbed the victim as she refused to marry with him causing grievous injuries on her person. No doubt the investigation is complete but the statement of the victim is yet to be recorded.

Keeping in view the gravity of the offence and the fact that the statement of the victim is yet to be recorded, the bail application is dismissed.
