Accused Raju Sachdeva @ Harish Bhatia not produced from JC.

This complaint has been filed by a public servant in discharge of his duties. He has moved an application for dispensing with his preliminary examination and for his exemption from personal appearance on the ground that he remains busy in official duties and it is not possible for him to attend the court on each and every date of hearing and that be therefore allowed to be represented through the Special PP. In view of the submissions made, the preliminary examination of the complainant is dispensed with and he is exempted from personal appearance during trial.

I have perused the complaint and the documents filed.

As per the case of the NCB, in pursuance to the information, on 14.06.2020, 250000 Tramadol tablets were recovered from parcels which were send/ diverted by the accused. Statement of the accused recorded U/s 67 of the NDPS Act and he admitted his involvement in the illegal possession, diversion/ sale- purchase of the recovered tablets in commercial quantity. Sample of the tablets were sent to the CRCL and same were opined positive for Tramadol.

I take cognizance of the offence.

Put up the case for supplying of copy of complaint and documents to the accused on the next date of hearing i.e. on 21.09.2021.

Copy of this order be sent to jail superintendent with direction to produce accused Raju Sachdeva @ Harish Bhatia on the said date in accordance to prevailing administrative instructions of that day. Copy of the order be uploaded on the website of New Delhi District.
