1. This is an application filed by applicant/accused Raju Sachdeva @ Harish Bhatia for reduction of surety.
2. Applicant/accused was granted regular bail by Id. Predecessor vide order dated 17.05.2024 on furnishing bail bond and surety bond in the sum of Rs. 1 lacs with two sureties of like amount subject to certain other conditions mentioned in the order dated 17.05.2024.
3. It is stated in the application that applicant/accused because of poor financial condition is not able to furnish two sureties and for this reason, it is prayed in the application that applicant/accused be released on furnishing personal bond of Rs. 1 lacs with one surety of like amount.
4. Mr. Yati Ranjan, Id. Proxy Counsel for Mr. Ratnesh Deo, Id. Spl. Public Prosecutor for NCB, submitted that he has no objection to this application.
5. Accordingly the condition of furnishing bail bond mentioned in the order dated 17.05.2024 is modified to the extent that applicant/accused shall be released on furnishing personal bond of Rs. 1 lacs with one surety of like amount. Other conditions mentioned in the order dated 17.05.2024 shall remain same.

The application stands disposed of.
