

State Vs. Rajveer Singh BA /3/2020 PBTC10000132020

Police record perused. Argument have been heard upon the application filed for bail on behalf of applicant-accused. It is further averred in the application that the applicant is an innocent person and has been falsely implicated in the present FIR by the police. The investigation in this case against the accused-applicant has already been completed and accused-applicant is no more required for the purpose of investigation. The application be allowed.

On the other hand, the learned APP for the State filed no reply, rather orally opposed the contents and has prayed for dismissal thereof.

Heard. Perusal of the remand papers reveals that accused/applicant is in judicial custody from 20.12.2019. Further, the presentation of challan and conclusion of trial would take long time, no useful purpose would be served by keeping the accused behind the bar. It will cause unnecessarily financial burden upon the Ex-chequer of the State, if the accused is not released on bail. Furthermore, bail is the rule and ail is exception. As such, the accused/applicant is ordered to be released on bail, subject to furnishing his bail bonds in the sum of Rs.50,000/- one surety in the like amount, subject to the following conditions:

1. That he shall attend the Court regularly and he will not leave the country without prior permission of the Court;
2. That he shall not commit an offence similar to the offence of which he is accused or suspected, of the commission of which he is suspected, and
3. That he shall not directly or indirectly make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any police officer or tamper with the evidence.

Application stands disposed of accordingly.

Bail/surety bonds furnished, which are accepted and attested.
Release warrants be issued forthwith.
