This is an application for grant of anticipatory bail u/s 482 BNSS moved on behalf of the applicant / accused **Rajneesh Kumar Gupta.**

Reply has been filed. Copy supplied. In the reply, it has been stated by the IO that FIR is not yet registered and the applicant / accused was called only to join inquiry on complaint received from the complainant.

Ld. Addl. PP for State submits that there is no apprehension of arrest as there is no FIR and in case, there is an FIR, copy of FIR will be provided as per rules, for which, no specific timeline is fixed.

Thus, in view of the above, the Investigating Agency is directed to give information about registration of FIR, if any, against accused within 24 hours of registration of FIR. The Investigating Agency shall also follow guidelines as laid down by the **Hon'ble Supreme Court** in "**Arnesh Kumar v. State of Bihar AIR 2014 SC 2756**" regarding arrest. **Accordingly, the present application is disposed off.**
