Accused Jot Singh has been produced by the police officials in the court and he has been sent to judicial custody and moved bail application on 20.10.2022. It is averred in the application he was forgotten the date and could not appear in the Court on 24.05.2019, 20.07.2019, 06.09.2019, 23.10.2019, 04.03.2020, 07.09.2020, 10.11.2020, 04.02.2021, 22.03.2021, 02.09.2021, 22.11.2021, 28.01.2022, 01.04.2022, 01.06.2022, 12.08.2022 and prayer is made to allow his bail application.

The perusal of the file shows that the present FIR has been registered against the accused on the allegations that on 24.05.2019, 20.07.2019, 06.09.2019, 23.10.2019, 04.03.2020, 07.09.2020, 10.11.2020, 04.02.2021, 22.03.2021, 02.09.2021, 22.11.2021, 28.01.2022, 01.04.2022, 01.06.2022, 12.08.2022, he remained absent without any intimation and, therefore, bail granted to him was cancelled and bonds furnished by him and his surety were cancelled and forfeited to the State and his non bailable warrant of arrest were issued and on 01.10.2022 accused was declared as proclaimed person.

Heard. By considering the allegations levelled against the accused and conduct of the accused that he himself has appeared before the Court after cancellation of his bail, I find that no useful purpose will be served by sending the accused-applicant Jot Singh behind the bars especially when the conclusion of trial may taken reasonably long time. In view of this, the present application is allowed and accused Jot Singh is re-admitted to bail, on his furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds for an amount of Rs. 75,000/- with one surety of like amount. Necessary bonds have not been furnished. Papers be attached with the main file.
