Offences : U/s.294(b),447,506(i) r/w.34 IPC.

Plea : Guilty

Finding : Guilty

Order : the accused no.1 to 3 are found guilty and are sentenced to pay  
a fine a fine of Rs. 500/- each for the offence u/s. 294(b) IPC and  
Rs. 500/- each for the offence u/s. 506(i) IPC and to pay a fine of  
Rs.500/- each and to undergo imprisonment till the rising of court  
for the offence u/s.447 IPC. In default of payment of fine each  
accused shall undergo simple imprisonment for 5 days.

This case coming on for today's proceedings the court passed the following :-

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**JUDGMENT**

The accused stands charge sheeted by the Sub Inspector of Police, Nedumangad Police station for the offences U/s.294(b),447,506(i) r/w.34 IPC..

2. The prosecution case in brief is as follows: The accused persons criminally trespassed into the courtyard of the defacto complainant, used abusive words against him, pelted stones and threatened to kill him at 7.30 pm on 7.5.2021.Hence, the prosecution.

3. Accused no.1 to 3 present. Counsel submitted plea may be recorded. Heard Particulars of accusation for the offences punishable u/s. 294(b),447,506(i),34 IPC were read over and explained to accused . To which they pleaded guilty. Then I specifically asked whether the submission is voluntary on knowing the consequence. They answered positively. Hence plea accepted. Heard . I am satisfied that the plea is voluntary. Hence accepted. Accordingly, the accused no.1 to 3 are found guilty and are sentenced to pay a fine a fine of Rs. 500/- each for the offence u/s. 294(b) IPC and Rs. 500/- each for the offence u/s. 506(i) IPC and to pay a fine of Rs.500/- each and to undergo imprisonment till the rising of court for the offence u/s.447 IPC. In default of payment of fine each accused shall undergo simple imprisonment for 5 days.
