**INTERIM BAIL APPLICATION OF APPLICANT RADHA
DAUGHTER OF MADAN LALA**

24th July, 2023

1. Reply filed. Arguments heard.
2. This is an application u/s. 439 Cr. P.C. seeking interim bail for a period of six months filed on behalf of the applicant/accused Radha (hereinafter referred to as applicant).
3. It is argued by Counsel for applicant that the applicant is in J.C. since 23.01.2018. It is further argued that the applicant is pregnant with 9 months and as the pregnancy is complete, the delivery of the child is required to be under the observation and care of family members and good doctors. It is further argued that the applicant is suffering from low blood pressure and paucity of blood in

her body which requires special care and donation of blood. It is further argued that the case is at the initial stage and only one witness is examined and no material implicating the applicant has come on record. It is also argued that the applicant has clean antecedents. Ld. Counsel for accused has relied upon the case titled as ***Shobha Gupta and Ors. Vs. Union of India and Ors.***, W.P. (C) 2945/2020 to support his arguments. It is prayed that the applicant be released on interim bail for a period of six months.

4. The application for grant of bail to the applicant/accused is opposed by the ld. Addl. PP for State. It is prayed that the interim bail application of the applicant Radha be dismissed.
5. Medical status report was called from the concerned Jail Superintendent. It is stated in the report that her vitals are stable. The applicant is admitted in Medical inspection room for close observation and evaluation. She has been prescribed Special Medical Diet for pregnancy as per jail protocols. She is under regular follow up of doctors posted in CJ-06, Dispensary and Jail visiting Specialist and all prescribed medicines are provided to the applicant from CJ-06 Dispensary.
6. In view of the medical status report, no grounds for grant of interim bail are made out.
7. Application for grant of interim bail filed on behalf of the applicant Radha is accordingly dismissed.

8. Copy of this order be given dasti to Id. Counsel for applicant/accused.
9. Soft as well as hard copy of this order be also sent to the concerned Jail Superintendent for information and necessary action.
