File taken up today on an application U/s. 482BNSS for extension of interim bail moved on behalf of applicant/accused **Himmat @ Sonu**.

Present: Sh. Sanjay Jindal, Ld. Addl. PP for the State.
Sh. Sumit Shokeen and Sh. Ankit, Ld. Counsels for applicant/accused.

Ld. counsel for applicant/accused submitted that vide order dated 18.09.2025 this Hon'ble Court granted the interim bail for a period of one week (from the date of release) to applicant/accused on the medical ground of wife of applicant/accused. It is further submitted that wife of applicant/accused is suffering from severe abdominal pain . It is further submitted that applicant/accused was released from judicial custody on 23.09.2025 at around 11:00 P.M. and accordingly, the interim bail of the applicant/accused is expiring on 30.09.2025. It is further submitted that after being released from judicial custody, the applicant/accused arranged his resources and borrowed money from his relatives and friends and took his wife for treatment and now the concerned doctor has scheduled the surgery of the wife of applicant/accused for 30.09.2025. It is further submitted that medical documents of wife of applicant/accused is also annexed with the application. It is prayed that the above said application may kindly be allowed.

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On the other hand, Ld. Additional PP for State strongly opposed the above said application and submitted that allegations against the applicant/accused are serious in nature. It is prayed that the above said application may kindly be dismissed.

This court has given thoughtful consideration to the submissions made by Ld. counsel for applicant/accused and Ld. Additional PP for State and has also perused the record placed before the same.

In view of the circumstances and the submissions of Ld. counsel for the applicant/accused that surgery of wife of applicant/accused **Himmat @ Sonu** has been scheduled for 30.09.2025. Therefore on humanitarian ground interim bail of applicant/accused is extended till **04.10.2025** on the same terms and conditions as prescribed in order dated 18.09.2025. **Applicant/accused is directed to surrender before the concerned Jail Superintendent after completion of extension of interim bail. Above said application stands disposed off.**

It is made clear that in the eventuality of postponement of surgery, applicant/accused shall immediately surrender i.e. 30.09.2025 before the concerned Jail Superintendent.
