Present:- Sh. Anil Rakhra, Ld. Counsel for the decree holder.

None for the judgment debtor.

Perusal of the record shows that as per the ordersheet dated 30.03.2024, Ld. Counsel for the judgment debtor has appeared before the court on the said date.

Ld. Counsel for the decree holder filed an affidavit to the effect that the decree holder has not received any notice from the superior court and also the decree holder has not received any amount from the judgment debtor.

Ld. Counsel for the decree holder requests for issuance of warrants of attachment against the judgment debtor for realization of the decretal amount.

Heard.

Report from the Nazir called. Nazir filed the calculation sheet.

Issue warrants of attachment to the tune of decretal amount against the movable and immovable properties of the judgment debtor, details of which have been filed by the decree holder along with the execution petition, on filing of PF within one week from today.

In the present case, the decree holder has also filed bank account details of the judgment debtor of Central Bank of India to be attached.

Today the Ld. Counsel for the decree holder has also submitted the bank account details of the proprietor of the judgment debtor in the affidavit bearing Saving Account No. 916010033587175 with Axis Bank Limited, Statesman House, 148, Barakhamba Road, New Delhi. Ld. Counsel for the decree holder submits that as per his information, this bank account is operational and prays that this account be ordered to be attached for the purpose of realization of the decretal amount. Along with the affidavit, the decree holder has also filed the details of due amount along with interest calculated from 01.04.2023 till today.

Heard. Considering the submissions of the Ld. Counsel for the decree holder, the Saving Bank Account No. 916010033587175 with Axis Bank Limited, Statesman House, 148, Barakhamba Road, New Delhi of the judgment debtor is also ordered to be freezed to the tune of Rs.82,21,261.58 and the Bank Manager is directed to freeze the said account to the extent of outstanding amount of Rs.82,21,261.58 only and file his report on the next date of hearing. If there is amount exceeding to the outstanding amount in the aforesaid bank account, the remaining amount needs not be attached.

Decree holder is directed to appear before the court of Ld. ACJ for appointment of Bailiff on 15.10.2024.

To come up for report before this court, on 11.12.2024.

As prayed, copy of this order be given dasti.
