1. An application under Order VI Rule 17 CPC with proposed amended plaint and fresh Statement of Truth, have been filed today. Heard and perused.
2. Through this amended plaint, plaintiff seeks to incorporate complete details in respect of outstanding amount and the contract between the parties. Keeping in view the initial stage of the case, application is allowed and amended plaint is taken on the record.
3. Issue summons for settlement of issues to the defendant through Speed Post/E-mail/WhatsApp on filing of the PF. Soft copy of complete paper book of the suit in PDF format be filed with PF. For service through electronic mode, AR of plaintiff shall file affidavit with respect to the correctness of the mobile number and email ID. Process be filed within seven (7) working days. Copy of the plaint, along with the entire paper book shall be served upon the defendant. The summons shall indicate that the written statement must be filed within thirty days from the date of receipt of the summons, and that alongwith written statement, defendant shall also file affidavit/statement of admission/denial of the documents filed by AR of plaintiff as per Order XI CPC as amended by the Commercial Courts Act, 2015. Advance copy of the same shall be supplied to AR of plaintiff or his counsel.

4. Tracking report of Speed Post shall be filed by AR of plaintiff.
5. Put up this matter for further proceedings/report of service on 03.09.2026.
