Present: Sh. Pradip Bain, Id. counsel for the plaintiff.

Defendant is not served with the summons. From his given address of office, it is reported that he is no more posted at that address. Other communications have been received from Assistant Commandant, CISF, Katwaria Sarai, to report that the summons received in the name of defendant, were sent to the permanent address/native place of the defendant, but it was found that defendant was not residing at his native place.

A tracking report of Speed Post has been filed by Id. counsel for the plaintiff with his affidavit, however, it is well apparent that this tracking report cannot be given any attention, in view of afore-said reports already received. It is not a valid service, if post are delivered at any address where defendant is not presently available.

AR shall also file affidavit in respect of verified e-mail ID and WhatsApp number of defendant along with soft copy of complete paper book. Thereafter, summons shall be sent to the defendant.

Ld. counsel for plaintiff seeks time of four (4) weeks for taking afore-said steps. Same be granted. Steps be taken within four (4) weeks.
