An application has been filed on behalf of the applicant for modification of one of the conditions imposed in bail order dated 19.02.2025 submitting that accused is permanent resident of Barabanki, Uttar Pradesh and it is difficult to travel to Delhi to mark his attendance in concerned police station. It is further argued by Ld. Counsel for accused that said condition be waived and accused may be permitted to mark his attendance at local police station near the resident of applicant.

Ld. Addl. PP for State opposed the application.

Application perused. Submissions heard.

Considering the fact that accused is permanent resident of Barabanki, Uttar Pradesh, therefore, permission is granted to accused Rajesh Kumar Verma to mark his attendance in the PS Special Cell, Delhi through VC on first Monday of each month till trial is completed. Rest of the conditions of order dated 19.02.2025 will remain same. Accordingly, the application stands disposed off. Copy of the order be given dasti.
