Fresh Detailed Accident Report (DAR) has been filed. It be checked and registered as a miscellaneous application in terms of Rule 21 of the Central Motor Vehicles Rules, 1989.

Vakalatnama is filed by Ld. Counsel for the legal
representatives of the victim.

He submits that the legal representatives are satisfied with the untraced report filed by the police and have no objection if Detailed Accident Report in case FIR No.218/25 registered at PS – Vasant Kunj (North) is accepted as untraced and the matter is disposed off without award of any compensation. Statement of Smt. Disha Tiwari wife of the victim is recorded separately to this effect.

IO submits that the final untraced report filed in the above criminal case has already been accepted by the concerned Magistrate, Patiala House Court, Delhi vide order dated 18.04.2026, a copy of which is attached with the Detailed Accident Report.

In view of the above, the present Detailed Accident Report is accepted as 'Untraced' which may be revived as and when any claim

petition is filed or accused/offending vehicle is traced out.

The legal representatives of the deceased are given liberty to approach the office of Ld. Secretary, NDDLSA for the grant of compensation under Victims Compensation Scheme, as per law.

File be consigned to record room after due compliance.
